Tournament Rules

- Alcohol may NOT be brought into the park. St. Louis Co. Ord. 616.060
- No nudity of any kind (including Zulus).
- Use permanent or temporary restroom facilities only. Public urination could be ticketed by Park Rangers.
- Please pick up after yourselves on the sidelines.
- All questions should be directed to the Information Tent.
- Arrive at your assigned pitch at least 5 minutes before scheduled kickoff.
- Forfeits are awarded 10 minutes after scheduled kickoff if either team is not present.
- Open substitutions are permitted except in the Finals.
- Please move your club to the sidelines immediately after the conclusion of the match to allow on-time start of the following match.
- All matches are 20 minute halves except for the Finals—they are 30 minute halves.
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by:
 - * Most number of tries
 - * Greater number of points scored so far in the tourney
 - * Winner of other head-to-head match in the tourney
 - * Conversion kicks from the 22—Referee to determine the point on the 22
- Brackets will be posted at the Information tent.
- In the event an ambulance is required, our medical staff will make the call. Please do not call an ambulance or 911 on your own.

Rules & Regulations

*Welcome! We hope your visit is an enjoyable one.
Compliance with these rules will make your park safer and more enjoyable for everyone
Please observe a few simple rules.*

Natural Life...Do not pick the flowers or in any way alter the vegetation growing in your County Parks. (County Ordinance 616.030) Also, do not deface or remove any rocks, stones or other native materials. (Co. Ord. 616.030)

Litter... Please use the trashcans and leave your area in an orderly condition. (Co. Ord. 616.150)

Helmets...Children under age 17 must wear an approved helmet when riding bicycles, scooters, roller blades, roller-skates or skateboards. (Co. Ord. 616.175)

Dumping...Do not dump garbage, trash or yard waste in County Parks. (Co. Ord. 101.130)

Speed Limit...The speed limit is a maximum of 20 mph in County Parks except as posted. (Co. Ord. 616.050)

Parking & Driving...Do not drive vehicles on grassy or unpaved areas in County Parks. (Co. Ord. 616.100 and 616.055) Public motorized vehicles are not permitted on park trails or service roads. (Co. Ord. 616.065)

Alcoholic Beverages...The possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages in any County Park is not allowed except by reservation or when purchased from a licensed concessionaire. (Co. Ord. 616.060)

Camping...Camping is permitted in some County Parks only in designated areas. Advance permits are required for certain areas. (Co. Ord. 616.130) Fires are allowed only in designated areas. (Co. Ord. 616.120)

Hunting & Fishing...Hunting is not permitted in County Parks. Firearms or guns of any kind are strictly prohibited within any County Park area except as authorized by law. (Co. Ord. 616.040) Fishermen must abide by the Missouri Wildlife Code and other posted regulations. (Co. Ord. 616.045)

Business Solicitation...Solicitation of any business or service is prohibited. No one may sell goods, maintain a concession or use public County Park property for commercial purposes except by written permission of the Director of St. Louis County Parks and Recreation. (Co. Ord. 616.160)

Animals...Dogs & cats are permitted only if they are kept on a leash. Non-domestic or exotic animals are prohibited. Horseback riding is permitted in the following St. Louis County Parks: Greensfelder, Lone Elk (reservation only), West Tyson – Chubb Trail, Sioux Passage, Queeny, Spanish Lake, and Cliff Cave. Riding is restricted to designated trails. (Co.Ord.616.140). Feeding or disturbing wildlife or department domestic animals is prohibited (Co. Ord. 616.040)

Swimming...Diving, swimming or wading in County Park streams, ponds or lakes is not allowed. (Co. Ord. 616.070)

Smoking...Smoking in County Park public buildings is not allowed. (Co. Ord. 101.220)

Excessive Noise...Excessive noise is not allowed in County Parks regardless of how it is generated. (Co. Ord. 616.080) Disturbing the peace of others is prohibited- music cannot be audible at a distance of greater than 50 feet from where it is being played without a permit. (Co. Ord. 616.035)


Permits...Reservation permits for use of specific park areas may be obtained by telephoning (314) 615-4Fun from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. weekdays or at www.stlouisco.com/parks. Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance and can be made up to one year in advance of the date requested. All facilities that can be reserved have a fee. A reserved area will be held for the permittee until the time designated on the permit. These areas must be occupied by noon on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. The Park Supervisor may give reserved areas to someone else if the permit holder does not occupy the area on time. The Park Supervisor or Park Ranger can assign an area not reserved. (Co. Ord. 616.170) Rule violations may result in the termination of the right to use park areas or facilities. (Co. Ord. 101.080)

Closing...All County Parks close 30 minutes after official sunset except as posted or by reservation (Co. Ord. 101.080)

Parking:

Please Carpool!

The three soccer fields to the right when you pull into the park will be hosting a tournament this weekend as well. There are 298 blacktop parking spots available for us to use.

We have brought on SEVEN Police and/or Park Rangers to assist with parking again this year. They will be directing you to either a “real” spot or to a spot on the jogging / biking trail that will be closed down for the weekend.

You can NOT park on Creve Coeur Mill Road or on Maryland Heights Expressway—you will be ticketed. Please tell your club / family / friends to carpool.

Speeding:

The speed limit on Maryland Heights Expressway / MO-141 is 45mph. Please be careful—MHPD makes good revenue off of that highway!

Alcohol:

Please be aware that you are NOT ALLOWED to bring alcohol into a St. Louis County park. You can only have alcohol if purchased by a licensed concessionaire. The only licensed concessionaire will be the MRFU Board of Directors at the Schlafly Draught Truck. Beer is very reasonably priced. Please don't risk getting a ticket from any of our 7 officers on duty this weekend.

Cash:

We will not have an ATM on site. Please bring any of your cash needs with you. The concession stand and beer truck only accepts cash. American Rugby Outfitters accepts cash and credit.
